



Occupational Health and Safety Training is a requirement before one qualifies for Open/Restricted Cabling Registration.

What do you need to apply for ACA Registration in addition to the Open/Restricted registration course?

- **Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) training including CPR (resuscitation training).** If you do not have this training, we can supply you with a self-paced learning module on OH&S for cost of \$100. You will also need to obtain CPR training with a first aid training body such as St John's Ambulance. If these are successfully completed you will be awarded module NTE001 (Occupational Health and Safety). ***Electricians and other qualified tradespersons are exempted from re-studying OH & S, as it was part of their training.***
- **You need to have at least 6 months cabling experience.** This can be electrical cabling, telephone, data, security or cable TV cabling; those qualified electrical tradespersons who have done building electrical cabling are deemed to have this experience. Verification must be provided by employer's letter or other verifiable documents (such as a registered electrical contractor).

The ACMA who sets the standards for Open/Restricted Cabling Registration requires that one has OH & S accreditation in addition to passing an Open/Restricted Registration Training Course. They also require the applicant for Open/Restricted Registration to have had at least 6 months cabling experience. This cabling experience can be in electrical, security, data or telephone work.

An OH&S Site Induction Card (blue, green, red or white card) issued since 2007 and a current CPR accreditation (Level 1 First Aid) will provide the evidence required.

Think OH & S! Have you had training in this in the past and have some documentation to prove it. We don't want you to have to repeat something you have done previously.

Ramsden Telecommunications Training offers a short remote learning module on OH & S, which can be done in your own time. The questions in the supplied textbook are answered and forwarded back to our office for marking. However, you still need to show evidence of completing a current CPR course.
